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Revenue and Taxation Code (R&TC) Section 19195 directs the Franchise Tax Board (FTB) to publicly disclose a list of the 500 largest state income tax delinquencies. If we determine that the corporation is among the 500 largest tax delinquencies, we will send the corporation a notice by certified mail advising it of the inclusion on this list of its name, address, occupational or professional licenses with status, and the **name and title of the principal officers of the corporation.** At the time of publication, **the corporation's occupational and professional licenses issued by a California agency will be submitted for suspension.** The corporation will be prohibited from contracting with any California state agency for the acquisition of goods or services. **Final determination of the top 500 names eligible for publication is pending confirmation of any resolutions or other qualifying circumstances for exclusion, including payment or arrangement for payment of tax liabilities.**

Pay the corporation's debt in full. The corporation may be required to remit payment by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT). Go to ftb.ca.gov and search for EFT. Once a corporation remits an estimated payment or extension payment over \$20,000 or its total tax liability exceeds \$80,000 for any taxable year beginning on or after January 1, 1995, it must make all future payments, regardless of the taxable year or amount, through an electronic funds transfer. Payments made by other means will result in a penalty of 10 percent of the amount paid (R&TC Section 19011). If the corporation is not required to pay by electronic funds transfer, enclose the above part of this notice and mail it with a check or money order for the total amount due payable to the Franchise Tax Board. Write the corporation's name and account number on the payment. **Use the enclosed return envelope and mail to: FRANCHISE TAX BOARD, PO BOX 3065, RANCHO CORDOVA, CA 95741-3065.** No additional penalties or interest accrue on the existing liability if we receive full payment within 15 days of the notice date.
